- Typology = the study of how God reveals his plan
- The Old Law is a preparation for the Gospel. "The Law is a pedagogy and a prophecy of things to come." (St. Irenaeus) It prophesies and presages the work of liberation from sin which will be fulfilled in Christ: it provides the New Testament with images, "types," and symbols for expressing the life according to the Spirit. (CCC 1964)
- ex. Adam > Noah > Abraham > Moses > David > Christ
