- I. Personhood of the Trinity
 - Person = from the perspective of (think grammar)
 - When God the Father acts/appears, it is God in the "person" of the Father
 - When God the Son acts/appears, it is God in the "person" of the Son
 - When God the Holy Spirit acts/appears, it is God in the "person" of the Holy Spriit
 - o It's all God!!
 - Just through the distinct "persons" of the Trinity
- II. Personhood of the Christ
 - as God
 - as Man
- *III.* Advent: "Always and not yet"
 - Purple =
 - o royalty
 - \circ renewal
 - Preparation for Christ
 - His birth ("incarnation")
 - $\circ \quad \text{The Second Coming} \\$

IV. Infancy Narrative & Typology

- Matthew 1, Luke 1
 - Fulfilment of the Scriptures
 - German play w/ Adam and Eve dropping gift at Manger
 - Any time there's water, it's baptism and Christ
 - Any time there's blood it's crucifixion / sacrifice
- Why was Jesus baptized by John?
- prefigures the Crucifix: taking the place of Sinners
 - John tried to prevent him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?" Jesus said to him in reply, "Allow it now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Then he allowed him. (<u>Mt 3:13-13-15</u>)
