### Definitions

- Number = 1, 2, 3, 4...
- Written numerals = one, two, three, four

1	one	6	six	11	eleven	16	sixteen
2	two	7	seven	12	twelve	17	seventeen
3	three	8	eight	13	thirteen	18	eighteen
4	four	9	nine	14	fourteen	19	nineteen
5	five	10	ten	15	fifteen	20	twenty

### Expressing Numbers

0	zero or 'o ("oh")	"no horse" or "zero horses"
1	one or a	"1 horse" = "a horse"
2	two	two horses
6	six	half a dozen
10	ten	
12	one dozen / a dozen	
24	twenty-four	two dozen
100	one hundred / a hundred	
1,000	one thousand / a thousand	
1,100	one thousand one hundred	eleven hundred
1,200	one thousand two hundred	twelve hundred
2,000	two thousand	<del>twenty hundred</del>

### Expressing Large Numbers

- Note: the word "and" can be inserted or dropped.
- Ex. 101 can be either "one hundred one" or "one hundred and one"
- a 'zero' is expressed either as
- Ex. 101 can be either "one hundred one" or "one hundred and one"

**Phone Numbers:**

- in English we do not usually read phone numbers like a large number
- ex. (301) 530-8670 instead of  
*Three hundred one, five hundred thirty, eight thousand six hundred seventy*  
 would be:  
*Three 'o one, five three 'o, eight, six, seven, 'o*  
 or *Three 'o one, five three 'o, eighty-six, seventy*
