

ESL Class: Week of Jan 4

- **Big Ideas:**
 - Questions and instructions (imperatives)
 - “Do-support” statements (declaratives)
 - Applying to Christmas and New Year’s vocabulary
 - ex. “Did you have a nice Christmas?” “Yes, I did have a nice Christmas.”
- **Opening Prayers: Hail Mary, Glory Be and Oh My Jesus**
- **Use of “do / did” in imperatives (questions)**
 - *Do you know him?*
 - Question forms may include:
 - *Do you?*
 - *Have you?*
 - *Can you?*
 - *What is?*
 - *How are?*
 - *Have you?*
- **Formulating responses by turning questions into statements by dropping the “question words:**
 - *Do you know him? >> Yes, I do know him.*
 - *Have you been to New York? >> Yes, I have been to New York.*
 - *Can I have that paper? >> Yes, you can have that paper.*
 - Note, when the indefinite is used as a question, the response may require the definite form;
ex.
 - *Did you see any horses? >> No, I saw no horses*
 - or, the question could be definite and the answer indefinite,
ex.:
 - *Do you have some change? >> No, I do not have any change*
